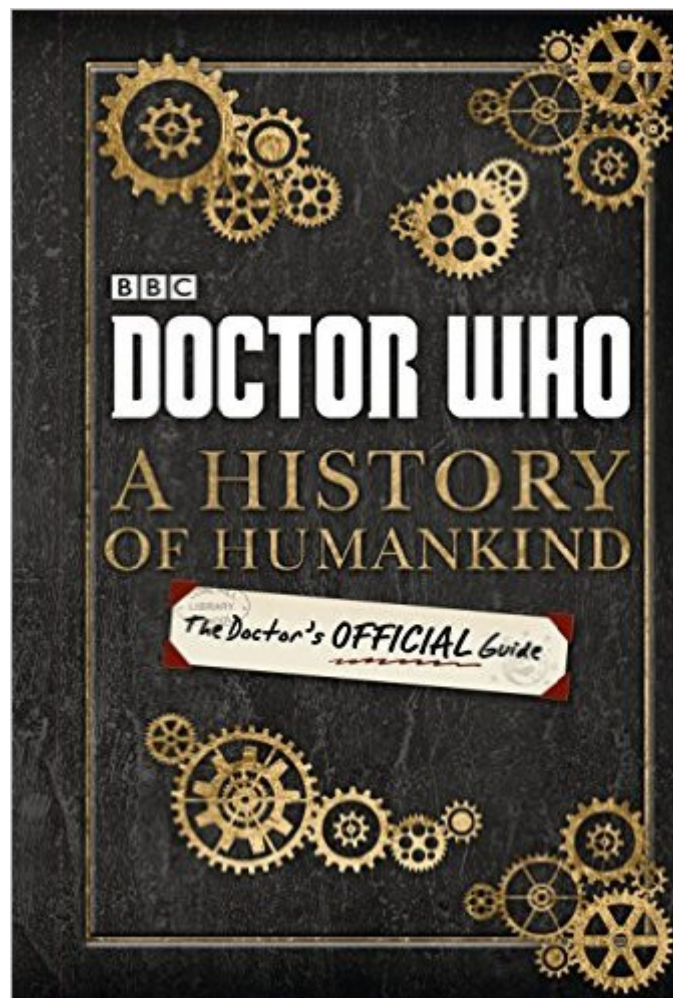




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Doctor Who: A History Of Humankind: The Doctor's Official Guide
