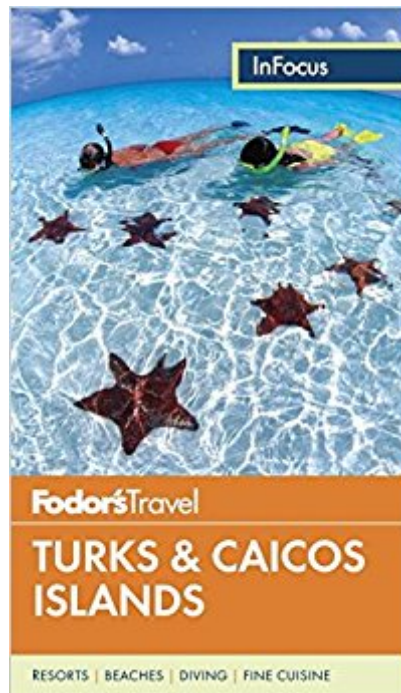

The cue in on the roundabouts & warning of driving on the right are well advised. If one desires to remain in one resort (and there are beautiful ones), a guide is less needed. Updates and good maps are crucial to take best advantage for those wanting to better appreciate the many facets of this unusual place.
