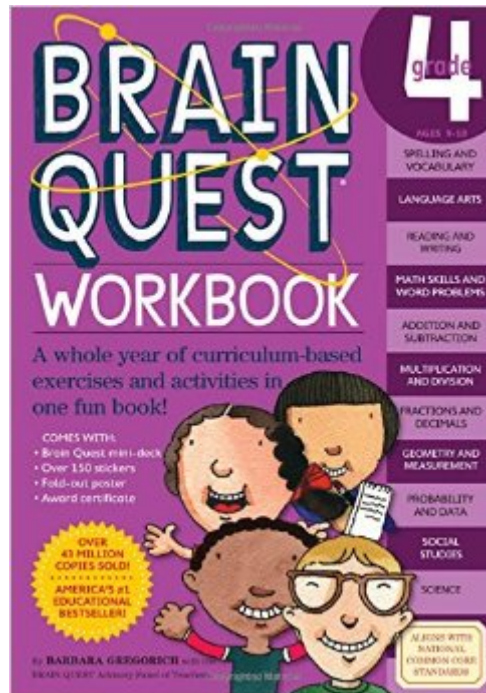

I bought this for my home-schooled son who is done with his work for the year. I have found several mistakes including this one. If you can't count on it being correct it's worthless.

My son is going into fourth grade and this book is great. Some of the work is super easy and some he needs help with. So, the balance of easy and tough keeps him interested without getting

discouraged. I don't expect him to "get" everything, for us this is just a way to keep what he learned in third grade fresh and just touch on what he will see in fourth.

These workbooks are incredible. A friend had given me the 1st one in the series because my kindergarten aged daughter was extremely advanced and becoming bored with the classroom criteria. She started on the first workbook and actually enjoyed going through each page all on her own. These books are packed full of fun exercises in many classroom disciplines and are easy for young children to follow. I purchased all of the workbooks up to the 4th edition and my child will occasionally pull out the color of her choice and work independently on the exercises. The learning material is relevant to the class work for each grade and has techniques of quizzing the children that help them understand the subject matter. The books are great for children that may be struggling or excelling in the classroom and would make great substitutes for summertime learning. Thumbs up on this learning material.

I decided to buy these books for my students as an end of the year gift. I bought the 3rd grade books for my OGL students and the 4th grade books for my AGL students. Wow!! They are much thicker than I expected them to be for \$6! They are written for common core curriculum so they don't fit within the more strenuous Virginia state standards but they will work just fine as extra summer practice. My kiddos will be very happy with this gift. ;)

I like these books to help my kids review over the Summer. I felt that Brain Quest has a more thorough workbook than other workbooks. It challenges my child but not too hard.

Bought this along with Summer Bridge 3rd to 4th grade. All I needed was this. This book is what we mostly use for our daily 2 hours of "summer school". All subjects are labeled, making it easy to skip around and customize lessons. This book has more lessons and worksheets than we will have time to finish before school starts, but I am planning to pull it out again during Christmas break and for those snow days that become snow weeks.

These books keep my 9 year old grand daughter past what she is doing in her 3rd grad class. We buy one each year and spend so much quality time doing these lessons in the Brain Quest books. Highly recommend these books.

My 9yr old really enjoys all the learning activities. It really challenges him and freshens up on his skills. Some of the other books I have purchased was boring for him or it felt like school work. This was actually fun for him.
