I've been using these Daily Paragraph Editing books with my daughter (third grader) and the students I tutor. These books are excellent for practicing editing skills, and the best part is that the exercises are focused on entire paragraphs and not merely sentences. The book is developed such that it is an all-in-one deal. First, you need to instruct the child/student on the proofreading marks (which can also be copied out for each child's reference), then the child is ready to work on the

paragraphs (each paragraph takes up half a page), and once the child is done editing, the teacher/parent/tutor can check using the answer key provided. The answer key is found on the page adjacent to the exercise but all the pages can be easily detached from the book so this should not pose a problem. The answer key is detailed and highlighted in red ink which makes it easy to refer to. There's a concise language handbook at the back of the book which covers the basic rules for writing and editing, and there are also writing prompts provided for writing practice. This book contains 36 lessons, and each lesson includes 4 related paragraphs with capitalization, punctuation, spelling, and language errors. There's a writing prompt correlating to each lesson. In conclusion, this makes an invaluable resource that can help students improve their editing and writing skills, whilst learning language conventions.

Love this editing book. My students utilize this on a weekly basis. It correlates with the standards - punctuation, grammar, spelling. Teaches students to be conscientious editors. I observe students' growth from the beginning of the school year to the end not only on these practices, but in their writing as well. AMAZING resource!! Highly recommended!!

As a homeschool family, we were lacking in the practice editing area. I was looking for a quick, simple practice book to reinforce punctuation and this is perfect for my nine and eleven year olds. My only complaint is the same that other reviewers had, the answers are difficult to hide if you're using the paragraphs straight in the book because the answers are on the opposite page. We fold the cover around the back of the book and it helps, but it tears up the book.

I purchased this book about 6 months ago and we have been using it daily (as it is intended to be used). I have noticed that my child has gained confidence in his editing skills and is getting noticeably better at writing. I'd definitely recommend it.

My kiddo really enjoys this workbook. Its a fun way to sharpen your eye for gramatical errors. She gets to play "teacher" and go through marking mistakes she finds with a red pen.

I moved to 6th grade English this year, and needed to get a new DOL book. This one was perfect. It's challenging enough for all students, and an answer key is provided in the back. I make overhead transparencies of all the pages so save paper copies. My principal loves it when teachers use DOL method to teach English. I don't use it every single day though - I go in spurts, then switch off with

other grammar exercises. I highly recommend this book for English teachers.
