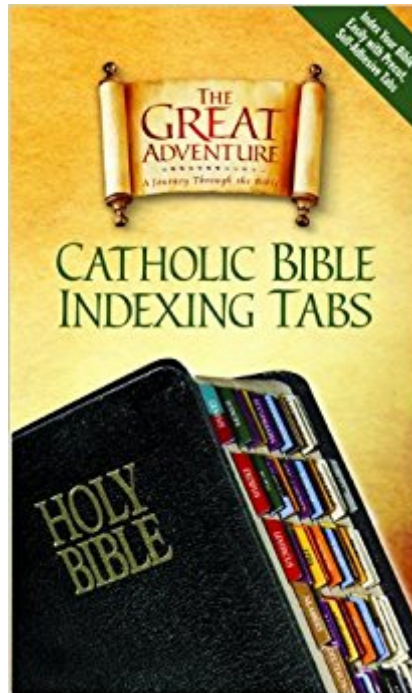

These indexing tabs are meant to be used with the "The Great Adventure" Bible study materials. They are color coded to correspond with the historical timeline available with the study materials. However, you can absolutely use these without the study program. When I got these, the local Christian paraphernalia store only had Protestant materials. I did not find Catholic tabs there. These are fantastic. I've had them on my Bible for about 5 years and look great! You get used to having everything labeled - there's a tab labeled Maps! Perfect for anyone just starting or the most seasoned Bible reader. Excellent.

I ordered these along with another companies tabs for my catechism. As a whole, I love the idea of having the tabs! There are some issues: 1) The Tab "guide" is a pain to use. I used it for the first two tabs and they came out awful. These tabs go onto really delicate paper and I ripped a page trying to fix one. I gave up using the guide after two tabs. The other company I bought tabs from suggest you start from the back and you can visually line the next one up. That worked like a charm! I wish I had

started that way.2) Some of them ripped as I peeled them off. I was able to still use them.Both of these problems are mentioned in the instructions. I'm not a fool, I followed the rules. It still happened.For the price, they look great. I like that they are color coded. It would be cool if they had a sticky color coded post-it like thing to stick on the inside back cover. That way I can remember what they mean without having to find this little piece of paper again.(In this picture, these tabs are on the bible. The top are tabs I bought for my catechism from another company.)

The best thing about these tabs is being able to take them off without ripping the page.The next best thing is the placement guide - all tabs placed perfect in 20 minutes; You can't beat that for easy! Cost is right, Delivery was fast and Easy too; best bang for my money.

I just received my tabs for my Catholic bible. After reading the application reviews prior to purchase, I thought I would buy them anyway.My suggestion is you can read the instructions if you want, however, really suggest you throw them away. You just need a pair of scissors. I cut the tab sheets so I had the tabs in sections. Doesn't matter what order, because you use each bible book to stay on course. Start at the back of the bible with Revelation and work toward the front. (If these are in the back of your bible, you could start with the Concordance or Dictionary, if you want.)On the tab strip, that has Revelation, fold each tab at the separation point. Cut each tab as you come to that book. Stay in your bible's order.Place the Revelation tab (or which ever tab you start with at the back of the bible) on the lower edge of the first page of that Revelation book.Bend the tab in half, GENTLY, but firmly, there will be two tiny side throwaway pieces (each tab has them), Just stick them to a release paper scrap for throw away after you are finished.Proceed with the next tab Jude), bend it, separate it from the release paper, then place it a little higher than Revelation, next is tab is 1-3 John, place it a little higher than Jude. When you get near the top of the bible page, start again at the lower edge and work up to the top again. Keep going until you get to Genesis.Caution points: Just be slow and deliberate with each tab. Bending and lifting it from the release paper. Place one side of the tab on the page, then fold it over. Viola!All like the tabs, they work for me, and they look nice as the second photo on the listing.

I just got done putting these in my Bible and am very annoyed with these tabs. But once I started I had to finish since I can't remove them due to the Bible pages being so delicate. The precut lines are not all cut well. So you end up tearing the thin clear sections to get them off the paper in order to put them in the book. They really need to put better care into the precut tear aways. I would never

order this brand again.

The labels are very thin. Which is not too bad if they were cut all the way though. Unfortunately they are very difficult to remove from the page they are attached to for shipping. Using a magnifying glass to see the clear edges. It would have been helpful to have lines where the separations are. Almost impossible to remove without taking the whole page off. In addition they tear very easily. Very disappointed. I have never had so much trouble labeling a bible. Extremely frustrating and time consuming.

Seriously, the greatest invention since sliced bread! Okay, so I am exaggerating... but it most definitely makes bible study a lot easier when you can tab to the right section without thumbing through and through for what you need. It took me some time (2 days - off and on) to get all of the tabs in. It's not difficult by any means, but time consuming because of the quantity and delicacy of the bible pages and the fact that you're working with stickers. I even messed up on a few and if you are REALLY careful and haven't pressed down on them, they came off okay and were fine to re-apply. They are worth the time.

Everyone needs this for their bibles! The colored tabs are perfect for quick reference and helps you remember the color coded system for the Bible timeline. I love that the tabs go along with "the great adventure" series which I just completed for a bible study class at my parish. I would recommend getting these tabs for every bible you own and it's a great gift for others.
