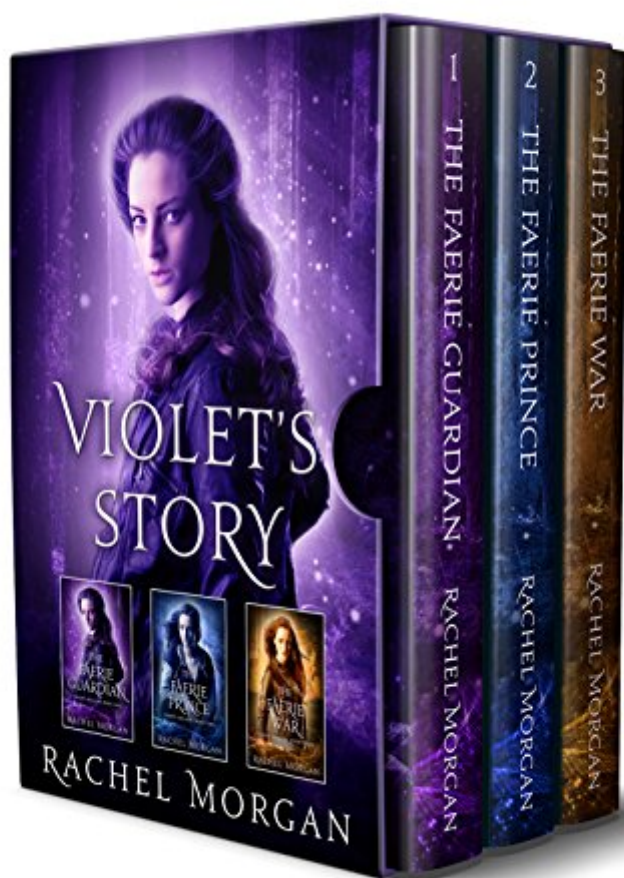


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Creepy Hollow: Violet's Story (Books 1, 2 & 3)
