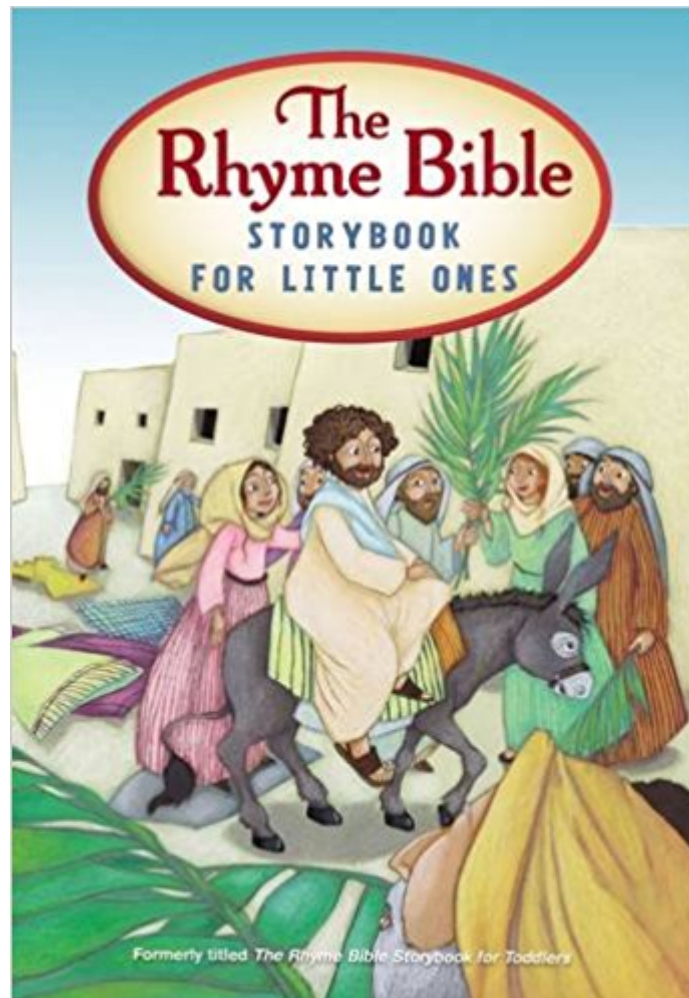




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The Rhyme Bible Storybook For Little Ones

This is the perfect Bible for kids aged 3 to 6. My oldest kids are 18 and 17 and my younger ones are 3 and 5. We read this Bible to our oldest two, and we are reading it now to my youngest two. It delivers truth with in a simple and understandable way, yet it is captivating and memorable to little minds. Also, it is beautifully written. If you are looking for a story Bible, pick this one. You will not be disappointed!

The illustrations are absolutely beautiful. It provides just enough information in clever rhymes.

I love this book for the poetry, but the older Goffe illustrations are so much better quality artwork than the newer edition's by another illustrator. The new artwork is juvenile and seems rather generic. I use this book to teach religion and reinforce reading, and the kids love the rhymes, but even they prefer the older edition in a big way. I usually give each of the kids a copy of this book at the end of every school year, but I won't be doing that anymore.

... Except the NIV or NASB. =)But for kids, this Bible is amazing. The rhymes are well written, the pictures are beautiful, and my kids absolutely love it. We got this Bible after reading the Toddler version of this book first, and were curious what else there was since our kids had memorized the younger version. We weren't disappointed. This version is much bigger and more sophisticated (but still within their reach/understanding), and it really goes the distance. The stories are longer and richer, with more detail. I would say this Bible is great for anyone between the ages of 2.5 to 5. We'll be buying many more as gifts for friends.

We bought this for our daughters to be a step up from the 'Baby Bible Storybook, for Girls', which we found to be too fluffy. By fluffy, I mean that we felt the stories excised too much. Obviously, for a baby the words and pictures and simple concepts like God loves you are probably best, the book just was not one they kept wanting to read. We wanted to find a book about God (a bible really), that 18 month old girls would *want* to keep reading. In 'The Rhyme Bible' we hit the jackpot! Our daughters enjoy the stories enough that we have been able to flesh some of them out for them (as in, Abraham and Sarah's boy is names Isaac - a story they latched onto so much that we have to read it *every* time we bring the book out!). The format necessarily means that many creative liberties are taken with the stories the book does present (and it certainly cannot present them all),

but I mark the success of this book on several accounts:1. It is currently the most requested book we read to our daughters2. The stories, short as they are, are beautifully illustrated and memorable3. It is an accessible introduction to God's story for a young toddler (a person who does not need a full theological introduction yet)4. The book is sturdy and well-constructed (a plus with two active toddlers!)All-in-all, we are very happy with how our girls have taken to this Bible storybook and are thankful for the simple, yet memorable way it is helping us introduce God to them! I only wish that there were more stories. It paints a nice picture, but a small one to be sure.

I love this Bible! Shipment arrived quickly, however did not meet my expectations for a book described as "new" because the front and back corners of the cover and pages are bent. I have no way of knowing if this happened during shipment or came from the seller in this condition. I would not feel comfortable giving this item as a gift because it looks damaged. Fortunately, I ordered it as a Bible teaching tool to be used in my own home with my small grandchildren and I'm sure we will be adding wear and tear ourselves. ã Â Â^Â
