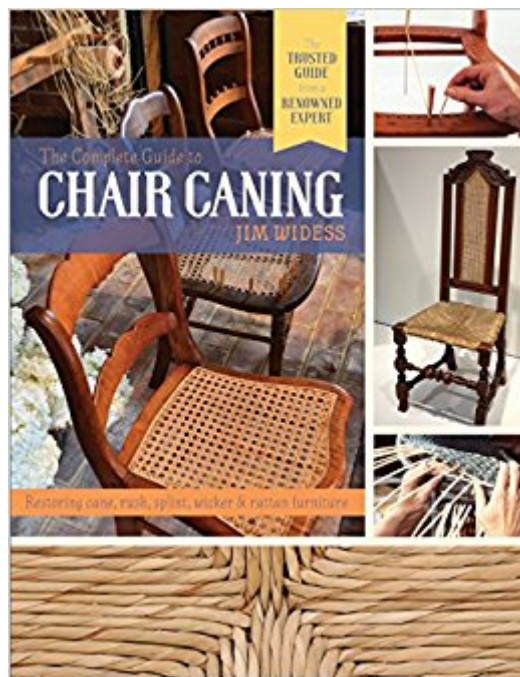

I had an old ladderback chair that was in need of redo. The instructions on how to do the rush technique were very good. Once you go a few cycles it goes fairly quickly. If you are going into rehabilitating any type of chair renewal for the seat, the information is very extensive. Lots of photos and drawings to explain how it is done. Mostly this work requires patience and attention to detail. I was very pleased with the outcome and so was my wife. Plus we learned a new skill.

I was mistaken when I bought this, I hoped it would cover much more than it did. It's such an old art and I feel like the author assumed too much from the reader. It's not a book that someone with absolutely no craft experience can use without consulting additional resources, so it's not at all a complete guide in my opinion. Granted I'm very hard headed and it's difficult for me to learn new skills.

I have worked with furniture restoration for many years, including rushing and caning. It has been several years since I have done caning and wanted a refresher. I was very pleased to get this book. It explains what caning is, gives pictured examples from simple to elegant, and has clear instructions and tips. (Since I have caned before, I would have spotted info gaps.) Good book, great price! gaps in info had they been there.
