

In addition to teaching, Professor Bleicher is active as a visiting lecturer and consultant on color psychology for clients including Staples, Inc., and The Savannah College of Art and Design. He is also an accomplished artist whose work is

included in many major collections and has been widely exhibited in numerous solo and group exhibitions both nationally and internationally.
