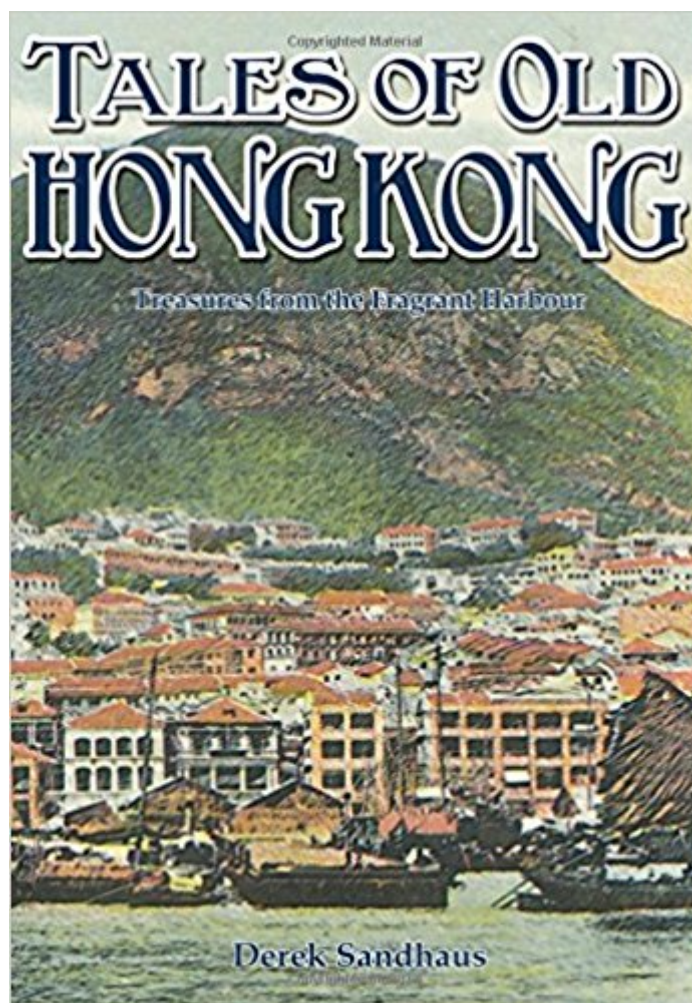


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Tales Of Old Hong Kong: Treasures From The Fragrant Harbour
