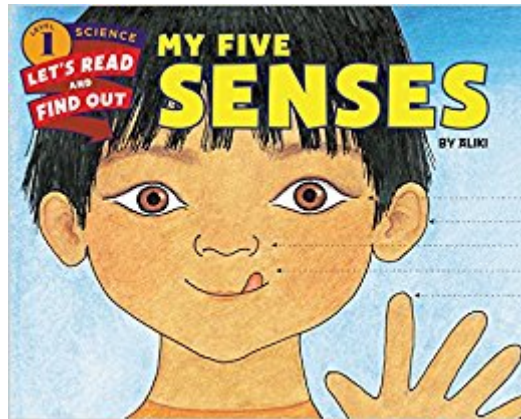

This book is excellent, even for a preschool aged child, as it really breaks down the five senses in a basic way. An example is provided for each sense and then, the book explains that sometimes senses are used at the same time- examples are provided for this concept, as well! I used it in my preschool class when our theme was "The Five Senses!"

The book was well written with nice pictures. I guess that my comments are more about how the book is marketed. It lists 4-8 as its target audience. As a parent read book, this should be listed as

more of a 2-3 year old book. I don't think that this would be my choice of a learning to read book. I thought that the book was about science. On that note, my barely 4 year old daughter had already learned about smelling, seeing etc. I had hoped that the book would have taken senses to another level, but it didn't. I would strongly recommend this book to parents of younger children, but it was regrettably a one and done for my daughter.

This book is perfect for our unit on senses in kindergarten. Well written!
