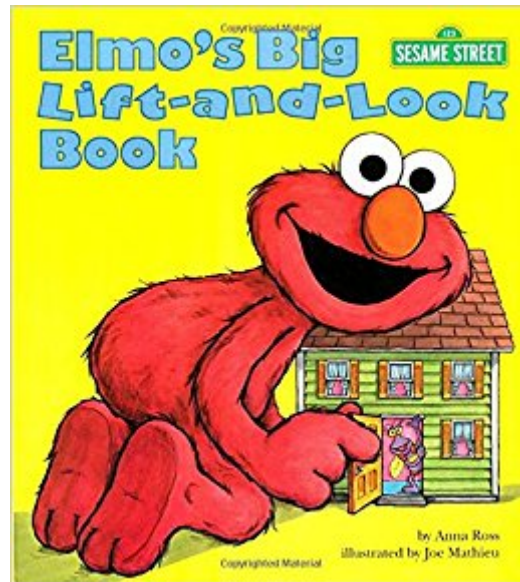

Sesame Street's beloved Elmo guides young readers to lift more than 60 flaps to reveal humorous and edifying surprises. Over the word "dry," Grover gazes unsuspectingly into a garden hose. Turn the flap and guess what happens! Grover learns all about "wet." A towering pyramid of alphabet blocks contains objects starting with the same letter behind each flap: alligator, book, cookies. Large, sturdy flaps allow rough-tough toddler hands to clutch and

pull as much as they want with minimal risk of tearing. Children will adore the bright, bold illustrations of Jim Henson's familiar Muppet characters and beg to return to this book again and again. (Baby to preschool) --Emilie Coulter

We first read this book at the library where many of the flaps were damaged or missing, and my 22 month old *loved* it. It features your favorite Sesame Street characters, bright colors, numbers, shapes, letters, and FLAPS! What could be better? There isn't really a story, the book is more about identifying numbers/letters/shapes and, of course, lifting the flaps. While it is an oversized board book, some of the flaps are smaller, and this is a book that is best for toddlers who have learned to be gentle with their books. I expect many kids reach this stage between 18 months and 2 years, but you know your child best. If you are considering it as a gift for a Sesame Street loving child, I think 2-3 years would be a great age.

This book is top of the line. Very colorful and bright, and there's so much to do! It takes me and my 1yr old forever to go through it because there are so many little "doors" to open. My son just loves seeing what's hiding behind the next door. The construction of the book is very hardy, the doors need a little more care when opening but it doesn't change the quality this book has. This book also has some great educational perks (colors, ABC's, shapes). It's very fun for a toddler and would definitely make a great gift.

She is a huge fan of Elmo, so she thinks this is the best book ever and she has a lot of Elmo and other various books! She's always had an interest in the lift-and-look books, but being an Elmo book, she loves it twice as much! You simply can't go wrong! Bright colors, cute pictures and sure to put a smile on your little one's face!
