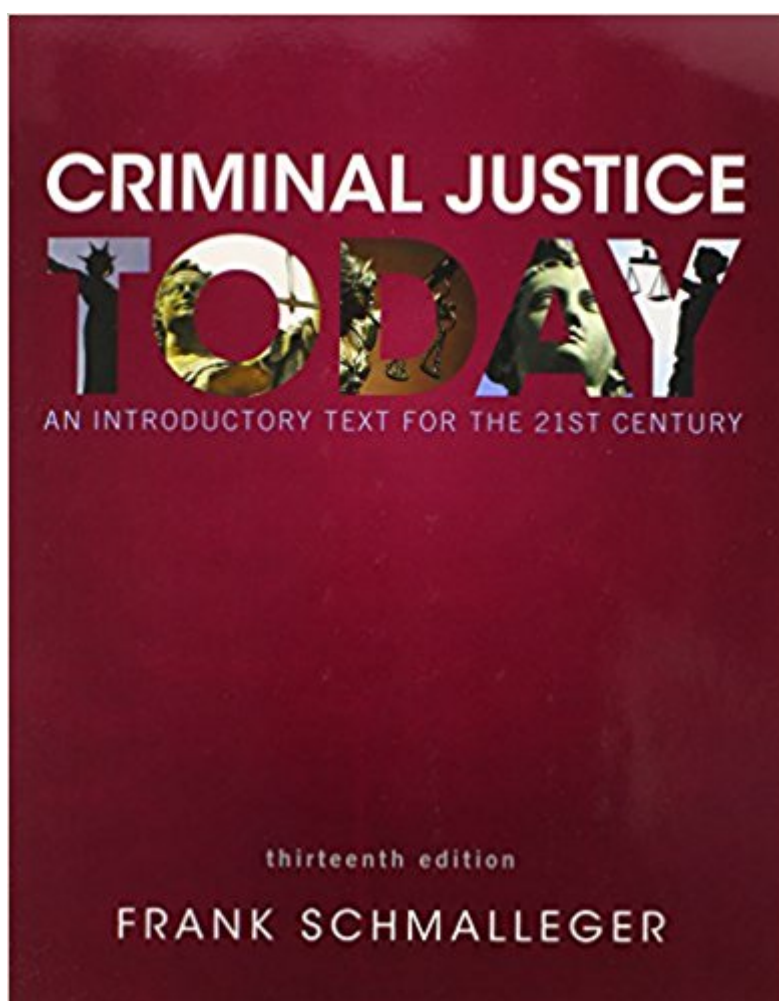


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Criminal Justice Today: An Introductory Text For The 21st Century (13th Edition)

Frank Schmallegger, PhD, is Distinguished Professor Emeritus at the University of North Carolina at Pembroke. He also serves as director of the Justice Research Association, a private consulting firm and think tank, based in Palm Beach, Florida, focusing on issues of crime and justice. Dr.

Schmallegger holds a bachelor's degree from the University of Notre Dame and both a master's and a doctorate in sociology from Ohio State University with a special emphasis in criminology. From 1976 to 1994, he taught criminal justice courses at the University of North Carolina at Pembroke,

serving for many years as a tenured full professor. For the last 16 of those years, he chaired the Department of Sociology, Social Work, and Criminal Justice. As an adjunct professor with Webster University in St. Louis, Missouri, Dr. Schmalleger helped develop a graduate program in security management and loss prevention that is currently offered on U.S. military bases around the world. He taught courses in that curriculum for more than a decade, focusing primarily on computer and information security. Dr. Schmalleger also has taught in the New School for Social Research online graduate program, helping build the world's first electronic classrooms for criminal justice distance learning. Dr. Schmalleger is the author of numerous articles and many books, including *Criminal Justice Today* (Prentice Hall, 2011), *Criminal Justice: A Brief Introduction* (Prentice Hall, 2010), *Criminology Today* (Prentice Hall, 2009), and *Criminal Law Today* (Prentice Hall, 2011). He is founding editor of the journal *Criminal Justice Studies* (formerly *The Justice Professional*) and has served as imprint advisor for Greenwood Publishing Group's criminal justice reference series. Dr. Schmalleger is also the creator of a number of awardwinning Web sites (including cybrary.info and crimenews.info) and founder and codirector of the Criminal Justice Distance Learning Consortium, a project of the Justice Research Association.

Almost everything of use you get from this book is vocabulary, anyways - and all of the vocabulary from Intro to Criminal Justice type classes is on dozens of different Quizlet flash card sites, just Google them. Most of the notes I took were from my teacher's Powerpoints, and were far more useful.

I purchased this text for consideration in one of my intro to criminal justice classes. If you are looking for the basics and the same old same old in a CJ text, you won't be disappointed. For years criminal justice education has been changing and unfortunately this author and others like him are resistant to that change. There needs to be a more creative way to teach criminal just at the intro level than by pumping students full of facts when they cannot think for themselves. Many of us are looking for something that will enhance problem solving and original thinking. This old method of "I tell you, now tell me back" is not education. There needs to be something better than this!
