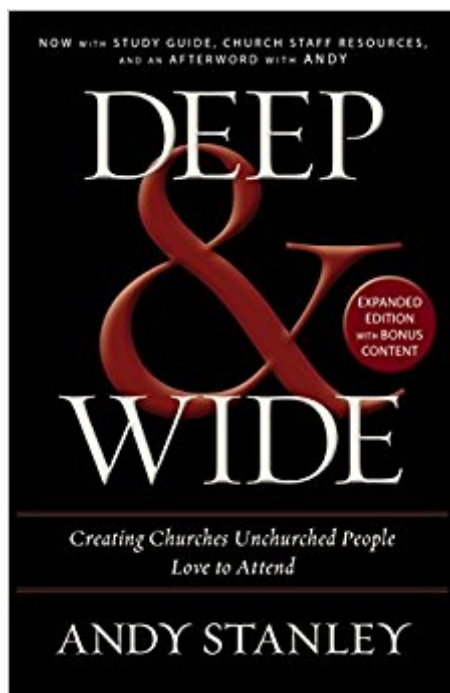

Communicator, author, and pastor Andy Stanley founded Atlanta-based North Point Ministries in 1995. Today, NPM consists of six churches in the Atlanta area and a network of more than 50 churches around the globe that collectively serve nearly 90,000 people weekly. As host of Your Move with Andy Stanley, which delivers over six million messages each month through television and podcasts, and author of more than 20 books, including The New Rules for Love, Sex & Dating; Ask It; How to Be Rich; Deep & Wide; Visioneering; and Next Generation Leader, he is considered one of the most influential pastors in America. Andy and his wife, Sandra, have three grown children and live near Atlanta.

Deep and Wide: Creating Churches Unchurched People Love to Attend is a great site map of the birth and development of the Northpoint Church in Atlanta, Georgia. Andy Stanley opens the journal of his early years in ministry giving a glimpse of the troubles and thrills of developing a new location for his father's church, the First Baptist Church of Atlanta. While the plan was clear to open a new campus, God took control as like-minded Christ followers prayerfully focused on developing a dynamic church for the "Unchurched" where people love to come. It is an amazing story and the mission, vision and strategies employed gives church leaders much to think about in the evaluation of their churches' effectiveness in these times. Andy Stanley does a masterful job of opening his

heart and soul to church leaders with no claims to developing a master template for all churches. However, it fills the reader excitement and some trepidation to change to a model far more like the "Early Church" than churches of our modern day.

You might not find yourself agreeing with every point made by Stanley, especially if you've grown up in the Bible Belt, and accustomed to a church culture that hasn't changed in years, but if you pick up this book you will be challenged as a church leader for sure. Stanley and his team are dead certain of their mission, vision, model, & programming at North Point, and its evident in this book. This is a must read for any church leader, despite your denomination or church model.

Some excellent suggestions for making a church movement Biblical sound and appealing to a broad cross section of people. Recognizing that what works today will likely not be so dynamic to future generations, Stanley urges a flexible approach to fulfilling our vision.

This is a must read if you have ever wondered how North Point became "North Point". Andy does a great job at poignantly giving readers the highs and lows of the journey. This can be inspiring for church leaders to ask the tough questions about how they reach their communities.
