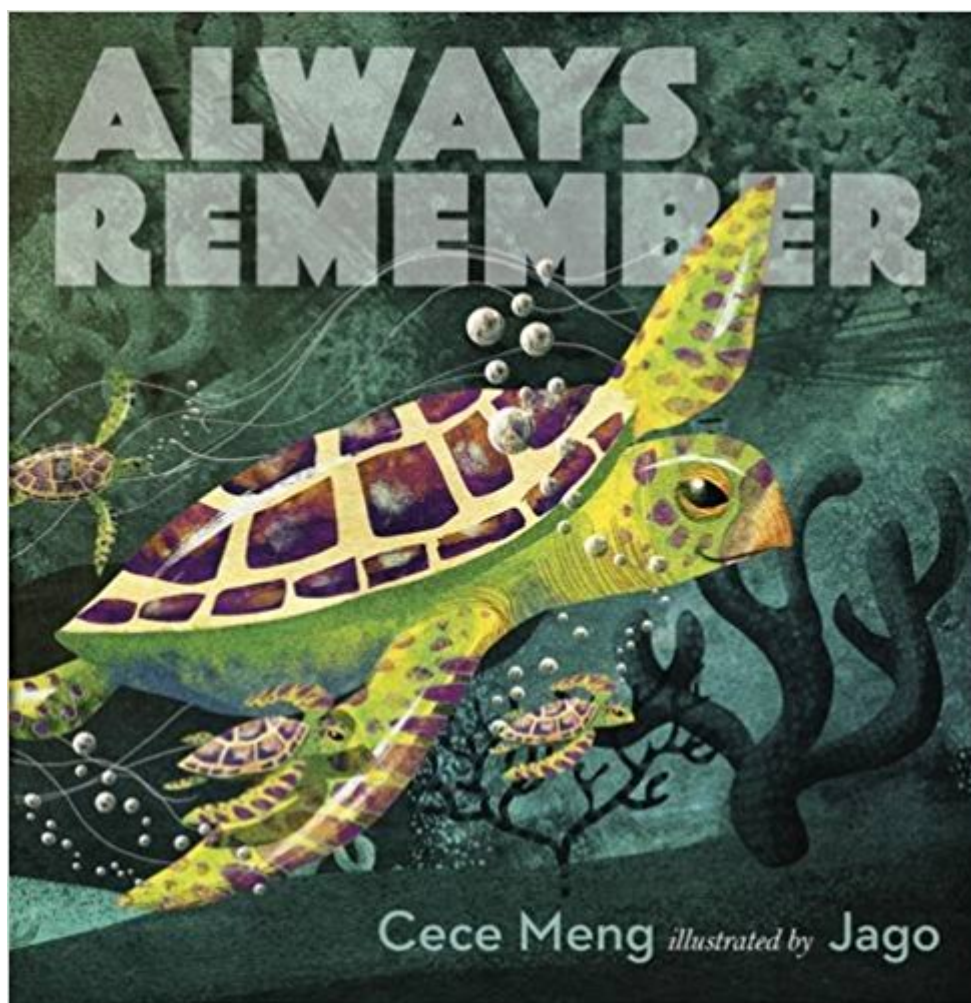

The story itself is one of remembering one who died, of cherishing past times together. It almost seems to be a book that halfway memorializes the actual loss of someone, and halfway celebrates the beauty of the sea. As a non-religious family, we were looking for a book to help our son process the loss of our dog without concepts like heaven. This book beautifully describes how animals/people have a legacy of memories even after death. I bought the book the day our dog died and waited for my son to be ready to process it. I had it on hand when he was ready, and we read through each page and laughed and cried as we reflected on our own memories of our dog. It helped us just as much as it helped him.

I had seen this book recommended in a magazine as good for children as they grieve a loss of someone close to them. I gave the book to a neighbor who has young children and just lost her father. The character in this book who dies is 'Old Turtle' - in my opinion this made it most appropriate for the loss of someone of grandparent age and not someone younger.

illustrations are beautiful. Although it is a children's book the message of remembering a loved one is appropriate for all ages. I gave this as a gift to a good friend who just lost her daughter to breast cancer. She loved the book and will share it with her grandchildren.

I bought this for my son when his grandfather died. By the time we were done reading it, I was all teared up. It does a good job of getting the idea across that when a person is gone, part of who they are remains in the things they did for others.

My library welcomed this addition. Lessons learned about life and death. Am sure the youngest in our family will be blessed in its reading.

This was something I purchased recently to explain death in non-religious terms to my daughter, after her grandfather passed away. The illustrations are gorgeous and the story is quite beautiful. I don't think my four year-old quite gets the connection to her grandfather yet, but it's a nice way to explain how the departed live on in the memory of the living, and it's become one of our regular bedtime reads. Highly recommended!

The photo doesn't do the illustrations in this book justice. It is simply beautiful. The story is a great reminder for adults, too that the memory of a loved one will live on forever in the stories we share about the kind of person they were. Not just in families but it touches on the many ripples of people (in this case sea creatures) touched by just one life.

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
