

They're good for making copies of the maps for our crews here at work (even though most of them have GPS) and I like using them for myself because I can't stand GPS units. I don't like fiddling with a GPS unit while I'm driving, especially in downtown Portland--too many stupid pedestrians jay walking everywhere, it's not worth it. I always research my route beforehand and at least have part of it memorized...but I suppose that makes me weird. Still, I'd rather have this in book form rather than in folding map form...I can fold a map with no problem, but it takes too much space!

We run a full-service design/build landscape and irrigation company in the Portland Metro area on the west coast... and have found GPS's to be helpful on the service side of our business. However, for our crews that are driving from our offices to the project site and then back... a GPS is a bit overkill. Thomas Guides are constantly checked, then rechecked for accuracy and aid in our routing, etc. We highly recommend the Thomas Guide for any business that hasn't already tried them and doesn't see the need to buy a \$200 GPS that can be lost/stolen/broken easily.

I bought this map book in preparation for a move to the Portland area. Now, after moving here I still use it to familiarize myself with the area of places i am going to for the first time. If you don't have one of those global navigators thing that are in common use these days, this is a good book to have. I like that it also shows where the stations are for the local light rail system.

We love the Portland guide. The spiral binding makes it so easy to turn pages. Since we are new to Oregon, we love exploring different areas surrounding Portland. Our GPS is helpful, but this guide is still useful to see where we are going in relation to where we live.
