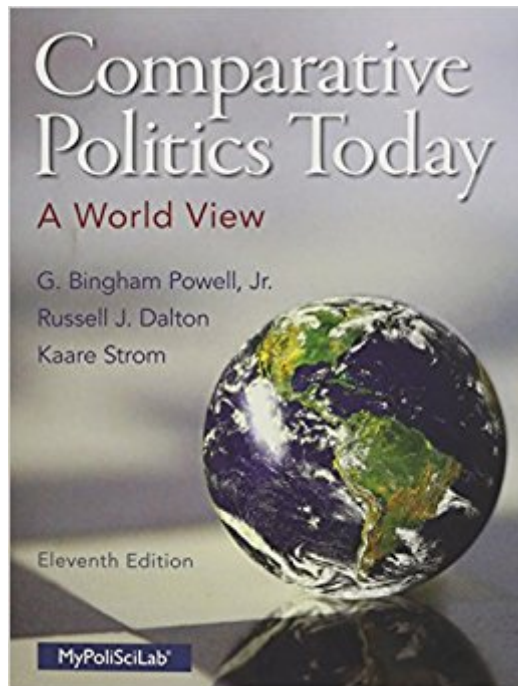


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Comparative Politics Today: A World View (11th Edition)
