

As a grad student with zero immunological background working on a lot of immunology, I finally got fed up with not understanding the jargon and bought this book. It's the best money I've spent on school yet! There are extensive figures and legends that reiterate concepts, and the appendices are bar none. There is an appendix that includes every cytokine, its function, and what diseases deficiencies or knock-outs of the cytokine result in (a life-saver for me!). I highly, highly recommend it, despite its VERY human emphasis and the fact that I work on various, non-model (mouse, etc) species.

Totally in love with this book. I really like paperback textbooks because they make carrying them around and folding the book to focus on one side at a time very easy. The chapters are not humongous and the text is spaced well. The pages don't seem overcrowded and the illustrations definitely aid in the understanding of the material. I found this book to be fun to read and great for an introductory level immunology course.

Used this book as a medical student (with no particular interest for immunology). As a general reference (or in my case a required text) for a medical student this book is far too detailed oriented for anything most will see on Step exams or in clinical practice (unless oncology/heme/immuno/rheum is your destination). Graphics and pictures are vivid and helps to distract from the frequently dense text.

Really worth the read since it introduces the material in layers (first broadly and then gets really specific). The images may not be the best compared to other books but it is easy to read and known to be the best book out there. The cd is trash, go ahead an trough it away to make the book lighter. Also there is space in the side for taking notes.

I have never taken immunology before. Given that, this book was required for my graduate level immunology course. This book is a great reference for the beginner immunologist, as it does not assume the reader has any prior knowledge of the topic but still offers the level of detail required to be successful at the graduate level. Text is supported by ample (and useful) figures and isn't insufferable to read. It has been a great help to me so far! Only draw back is that it is not hard cover so it doesn't stand up well to the wear and tear of toting to and from class.

Quite useful when learning the basic of immunology. However, in graduate study program, I found that this book may lack some information. Some of the stuff we learned in class was not covered in this book. As a result, I believe this book is more useful for those who needed a summary/review of the main idea and concepts to study for board exams or those who are in undergraduate immunology courses.

There are other immunology books out there that are a lot clearer, but Janeway is the most detailed. The style is somewhere between stupefying and catatonic.

The author does a great job of explaining the material, and the illustrations are very helpful. I'd recommend this to anyone who wants a good introduction to immunology. I always felt this was the most difficult topic in all of biology, but this book helped me understand the immune system and how

it operates. A great read!!!
