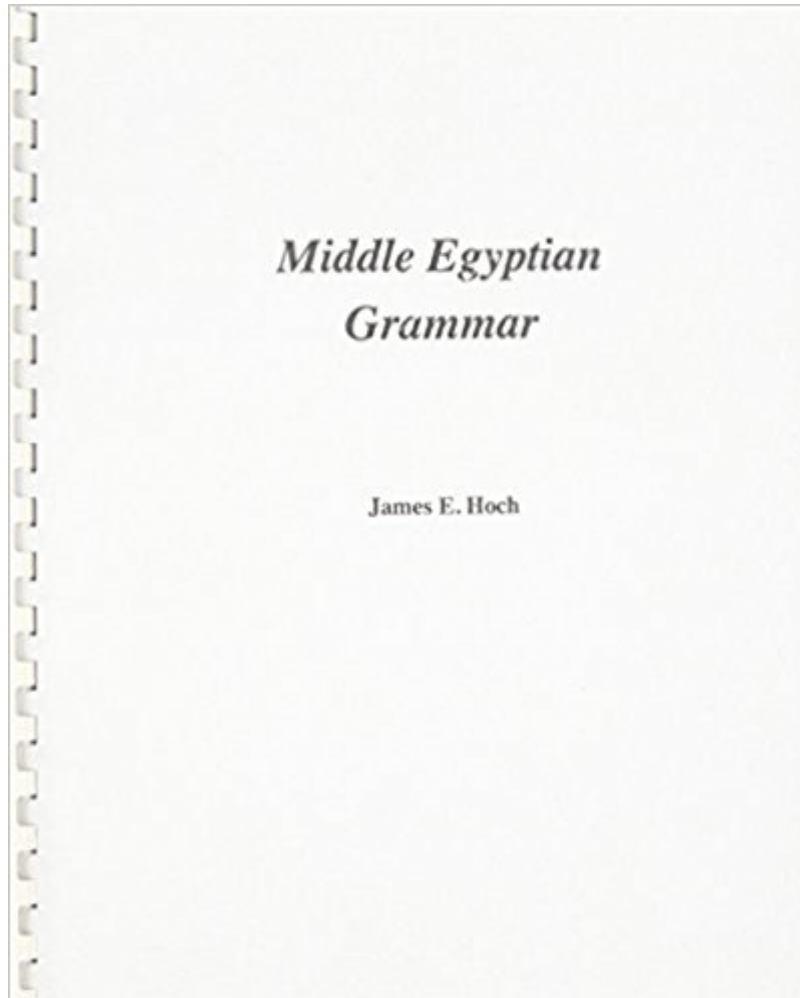




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Middle Egyptian Grammar (SSEA Publications)



Synopsis

This is a practical, modern introductory grammar for classroom and self-instruction. Unlike Alan Gardiner's monumental Egyptian Grammar, this is not intended as a reference work, and it is designed to be as user-friendly as possible by, for example, presenting simplified forms of genuine texts rather than diving straight into the originals. It is suggested the the 16 lessons be spread over about 30 weeks study. The book is widely used in North American courses.

If you are learning middle Egyptian on your own, this is a great book to have along with Allen or Gardner's books on the language. I've studied hieroglyphics on my own, and it was handicapped because I knew so little about grammar, English or otherwise. Gardner's book on Egyptian was probably written for someone familiar with the study of languages (which is no criticism, it is a great book to learn from) and doesn't explain much about the grammar terms used. Allen's book does explain the grammar, and is also a great book for home study. BUT I would definitely add Hoch to Gardner and or Allen--there is something so clear about his explanations, and his discussions about confusion in grammatical terms applied to Egyptian is a huge help. It is very hard as a self-taught beginner to know when I'm confused because I haven't mastered the material, and when I am confused because of the material itself. Hoch takes the time to discuss the underlying logic of the Egyptian language, and any conflicts between that logic and the logic of grammatical terms that we apply to it. That was a huge help to me. For an amateur, I wouldn't use Hoch's book alone, as his material is a little less "see Jane run,"

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
