

This guide is nicely organized by common name, order, and family. It contains many lesser-known insects in addition to the most noticeable ones usually included in field guides. The photos are beautiful and show the characteristics of each insect. Each section includes a few notes about the characteristics and natural history of the order or family. This is a great book for people who want to dig a little deeper into entomology because it gives an idea of insect diversity without being overwhelming, and it's portable enough to carry in a backpack.

For those who are interested in insects and want to identify the ones they see, this is a fine addition to your field guide library. This book is filled with excellent photographs. Although I live in Illinois, this guide will still be a help to me. Of course, there are so many insect species in eastern North America, no guide comes close to being comprehensive. I use several field guides as well as internet resources and am still not able to identify all the insects I see down to the species level. Nevertheless, this field guide will be a useful addition to my available resources.

A pocketable, concise, easy to use field book for identifying most of the more common insects of the northeastern United States. I heartily recommend it for anyone interested in learning about the myriad of insects that interact with anyone visiting the outdoors.
