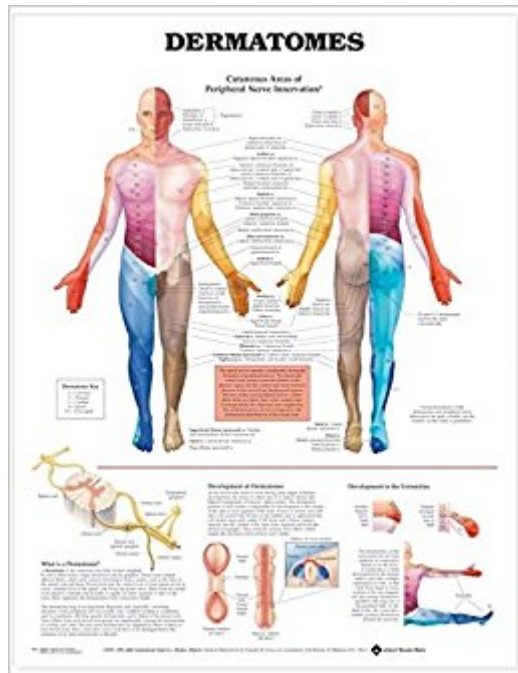

The description did not indicate that the paper was not laminated or coated with any form of protective surface. That was a disappointment considering the cost.

I buy lots of stuff from for my psychotherapy office. The back is plain paper and it is not laminated. It arrived very wrinklet (faulty packaging and I would have returned it for that as well because it was badly wrinkled) But it also just not what I expected at all.

As others have states it does not come laminated. I put mine in the back of my car to take to work, with a weighted bag on top to help it lie flat after arriving rolled up, It was literally torn up by the time I got to work. Needless to say it is a very flimsy poster.

States it's laminated and it's not! Wrapped in plastic but still had a small tear on top! Need to provide more accurate information if product

The chart is very good but not excellent. Colour coding pathways was a good idea however in places differentiation between the blue shades can be difficult. As a clinician this is not a problem

but the purpose, for me, of this chart is to help educate patients. This is made slightly more difficult if the pathways are not crystal clear. (Most patients do not have medical training). This chart would be useful for med students however. Pin it on your wall as a study aid. Spot-on.
