

... it was free via Kindle Unlimited. This "book" is not at all true to its subtitle which states that it is: "A Critical Look at the Beasts of Game of Thrones". It is simply a hodge-podge of material lifted from various sources such as: the first five books of ASOIAF and more recently published work, "The World of Ice and Fire". Additionally, the author throws in descriptions of some scenes (those which included the dragons ) from the TV series (ending at the conclusion of Season 6). I'm surprised that this even exists. When one considers how closely this "Critical Look" resembles plagiarism. The author plays the game many students sadly become adept at & continue right into their adult lives: representing that which is supposed to be their original work, while in reality it's simply a regurgitation of another's words and ideas. If the above is not bad enough: it is rife with both grammatical and spelling errors. It's incredible what gets published these days. Overall, a sad commentary on our times...
