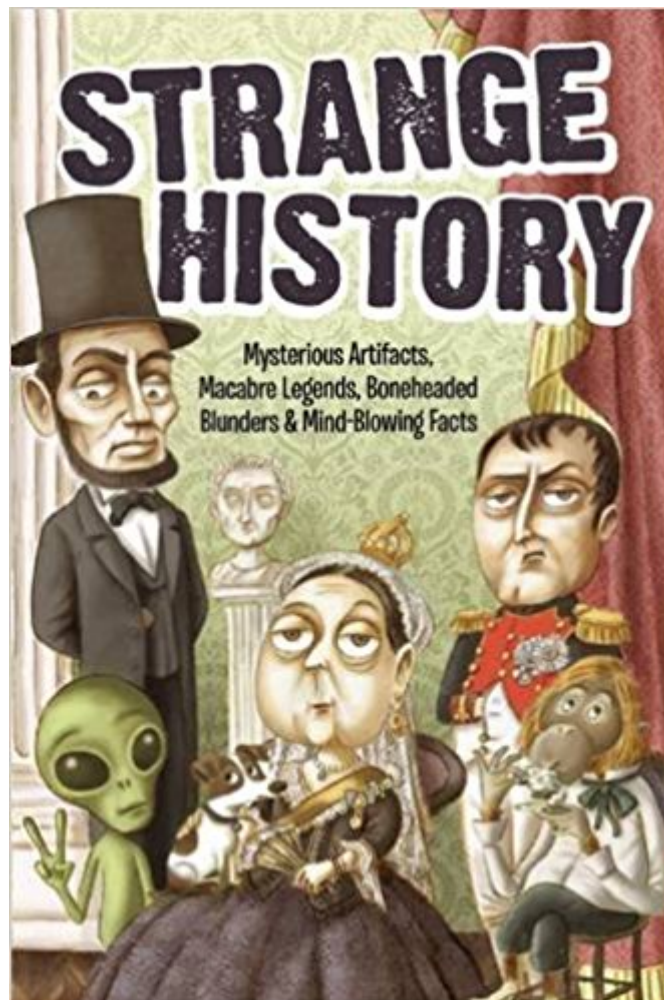

This an interesting and fun book. It's a little different format and a little fancier than the typical bare-bones Bathroom Reader books. The articles are also shorter, with most being a single page and a handful being two pages. I was slightly disappointed (but still love the book) that by its title I assumed the articles would all be anecdotes or insightful tidbits about historical people and events... which it kinda is, but really, they throw almost anything in here - some of which is very light, and you would have a hard time classifying as a "history" story. That said, I may like this book more than the typical BRI book.

A nice compilation of previously printed material plus some new material.

Interesting historical stories. I thoroughly enjoyed reading the book.

One would expect a coffee table book to be a conversation piece, but this book has sparked more conversations than ever imagined! If there's a sequel, we will definitely have it in our other bathrooms.
