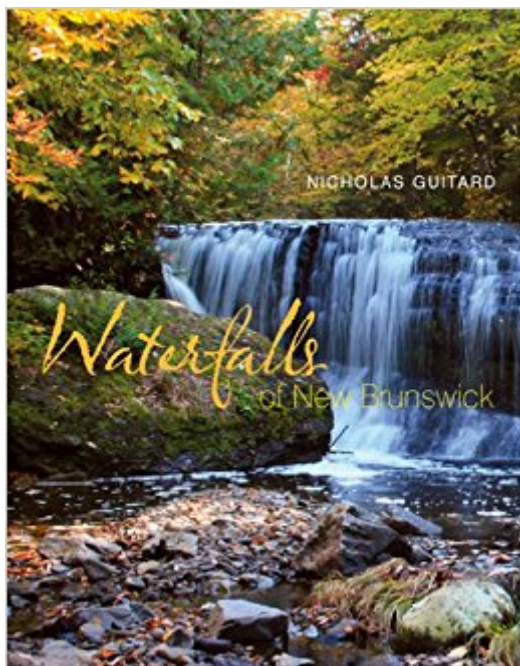

Guitard's photographs are composed with an eye to the diversity and particular beauty and geological situation of each watercourse. A map locates each waterfall. Spanning all five regions of New Brunswick (Acadian Coastal, Appalachian Range, River Valley Scenic, Fundy Coastal, and Miramichi River), there's something for everyone – you may even want to strap on your backpack and head out to experience them yourself.

Although the author lists waterfalls for all access levels, the book is short on driving directions. It would be helpful if he had included such information (which is available on his Web site) in the book. The way things are now, I'll have to print the driving directions off the Web site and insert them into the book -- not very convenient. I see that a new edition is supposed to be published in spring 2010. I wonder if it will include the driving directions.
